Toronto Railway Museum (TRM) to Celebrate Doors Open Toronto May 25 and May 26

Toronto, ON - The Toronto Railway Museum (TRM) today announced a Doors Open Event taking place Saturday, May 25 and Sunday, May 26. The event will be held at the Toronto Railway Museum inside Stalls 15-17 of the John Street Roundhouse, and outside in Roundhouse Park. Activities run from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm and admission is free for the entire weekend! Visitors can expect guided tours, a model train show, park animations, and the return of the Miniature Train (weather permitting). The museum store located in Don Station will also be open during the event.

"TRM is thrilled to once again be a participating Doors Open Toronto venue," said Pat Ressa, Toronto Railway Historical Association Chair. "As one of the museum's favourite traditions, Doors Open kicks off our busy summer season. This year's Doors Open theme, Hidden Histories, is particularly apt; we're looking forward to welcoming visitors and connecting them with Toronto's railway past at the John Street Roundhouse."

Doors Open Toronto showcases some of the most architecturally, culturally and socially significant sites across the city. This includes the Toronto Railway Museum, which first opened its doors in 2010. TRM has celebrated Doors Open annually since 2002.
